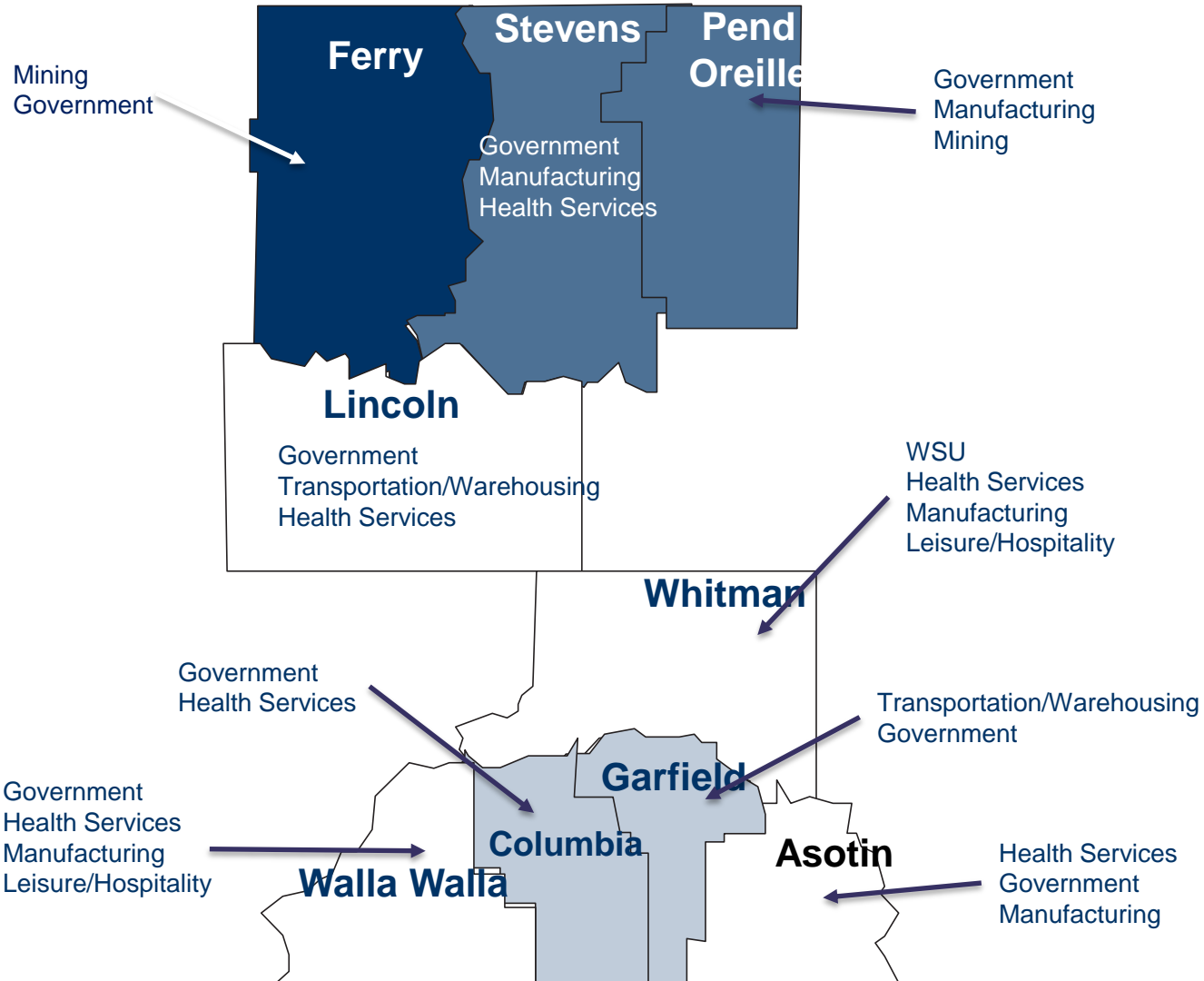
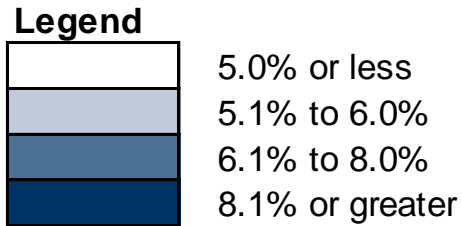

Major Industries by County



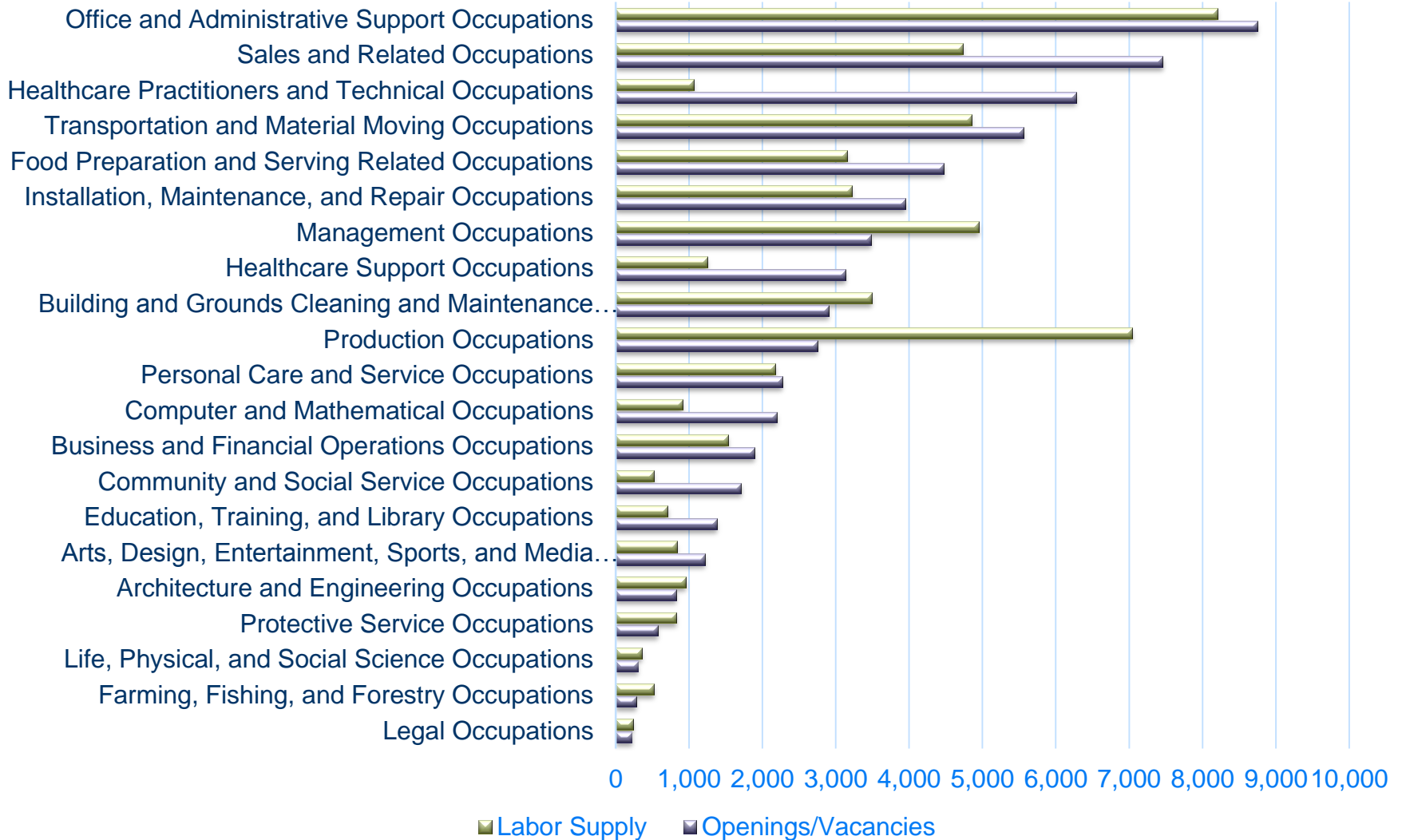
